## **Review of the Past Season**

The society had a busy and successful 2022–23 season, with concerts at Wye Church and the Colyer-Fergusson Hall, University of Kent, Canterbury, as well as our annual carol concert in aid of local charities.

November 2022 saw a performance of Handel's Samson at Wye Church. Among our soloists it was good to hear Hazel Neighbour (soprano), who sang with ACS while at school, give a spirited performance as Delilah.

In December we continued our 60-year-old tradition of raising money for charity through a combination of our annual carol concert and singing by invitation at selected venues. This year we raised over £1,400 for Ashford Family Food Bank and Crossroads Care Kent. We also provided a small choir, at the request of hospital management, to perform carols in the week before Christmas, in an outside courtyard at the William Harvey Hospital, joined by nurses, doctors and patients (on beds) of the ITU.

January 2023 began with rehearsals for Fauré's Requiem and Vierne's Messe Solennelle, performed to a packed audience at Wye Church in March. Our soprano soloist for the Fauré was Matilda Dawes (soprano), granddaughter of much-missed ACS bass Charles Dawes. The rarely performed Vierne was particularly interesting to sing and the powerful organ accompaniment was tackled with relish by our wonderful accompanist, Tim Woodhead.

We rounded off the season with a performance of Haydn's Creation at the Colyer-Fergusson Hall in May, an occasion when everything seemed to come together at exactly the right time. We certainly finished the 2022–23 season on a high.



Since the pandemic all choral societies have been struggling financially – a combination of declining membership, increasing costs for rehearsal and performance venues, higher fees for orchestral players and soloists, and lack of grants. To secure the future of the society, it has been decided to raise the annual subscription to £144, equivalent to around £4.50 per rehearsal. Excellent value for all the joy that learning and singing together brings – not to mention the opportunity for each member to participate in concerts at a very high level, with orchestra and professional soloists.
